Summer English & Cultural Immersion Program

Our summer intensive language and cultural immersion programs are designed for pre-university and university students living outside of Canada who would like to combine high-quality English as Second Language studies with an intercultural experience. Classroom activities integrate listening, reading, speaking and writing skills which help the student to apply and improve their language abilities while introducing them to different aspects of Canadian life and culture. Extracurricular activities range from organized sports, trips to shopping areas, cinemas or restaurants, where students will have ample opportunity to practice their English in real-life settings
