

In November 2023, OIA Manager, Strategic Initiatives and Special Projects Paul Leegsma along with Dr. Dawn Martin-Hill (Mohawk, Wolf Clan), inaugural Paul R. McPherson Indigenous Studies Chair at McMaster and David Cano, Director of McMaster's Office of Sustainability co-presented "Integrating the UN-SDGs & Indigenous Worldviews in the International Engagement of Higher Education Institutions" at the annual Conference of the Americas on International Education organized by the Inter-American Organization for Higher Education. The conference is a multi-lingual forum for higher education leaders in the Americas to discuss and exchange ideas on international engagement and explore opportunities for partnership.

University and Hamilton Health Sciences

On November 13, the Office of International Affairs kicked off "Approaches to Medical Education and Research at McMaster University and Hamilton Health Sciences," an online workshop for a group of twenty-six medical professionals from the First Affiliated Hospital to the University of Science and Technology of China (USTC).

The five-day program with a focus on problem-based and evidence-based learning is the second training workshop McMaster has offered to USTC's medical school. Vice Provost Dr. Bonny Ibhawoh welcomed the group at the opening session and assured that the continuation of the training initiative would lead to closer cooperation between McMaster and USTC in the areas of scholarly exchange, education and research.
