## A Summer Experience at McMaster University -English & Cultural Immersion Program

Our summer intensive language and cultural immersion programs are designed for pre-university and university students who would like to develop the academic English skills for a successful transition into their university program in the future. The program combines academic English studies with an inter-cultural experience. Classroom activities integrate listening, reading, speaking and writing skills which help students to apply and improve their language abilities while introducing them to different aspects of Canadian life and culture. Extracurricular activities range from organized sports, performing activities, trips to recreational places, shopping areas or cinemas, where students will have ample opportunity to practice their English in a real-life setting program.
