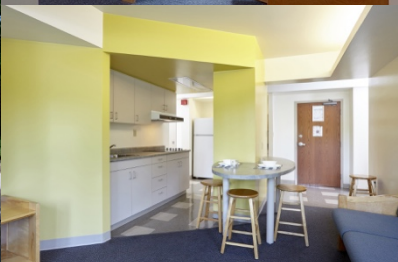
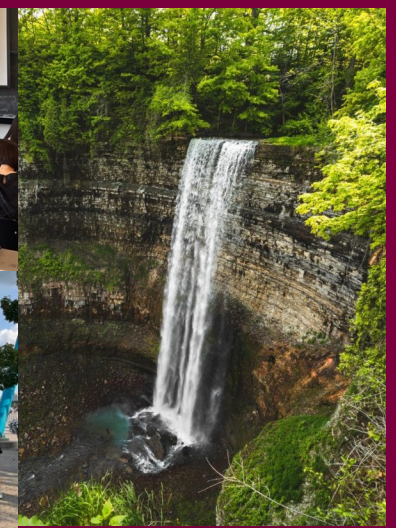

- Visits to local historic and scenic sites

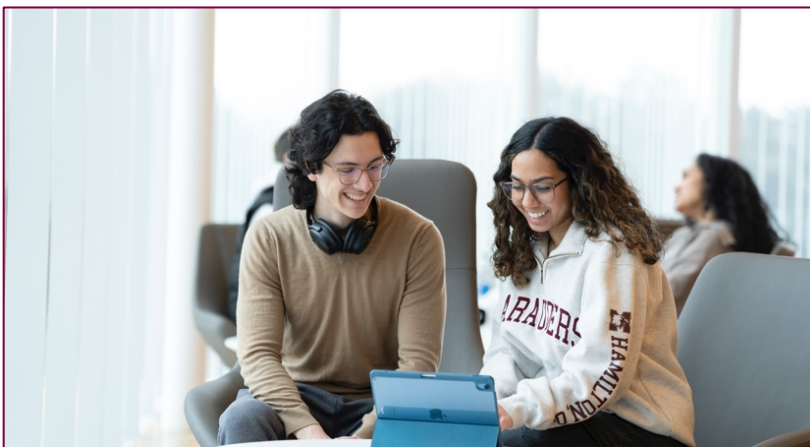
